CAVB Board of Administration Meeting in Cairo

CAVB board of administration meeting will be held in Cairo from 21 to 23 November in presence of all members. The meeting will discuss Implementation on 2001 CAVB Congress decisions which was held in Cairo after the transfer of the headquarters from Cote D'Ivoire.

The most important decision to be taken in this meeting is to set up 2002-2004 competitions calendar with master plan for the events and how to respect the deadline dates of these competitions from both the organizing country and the participating national federations.

Also they will discuss the establishment of

the development programmes for the coming years and how to start the Height limit competitions to start this category of volleyball as permitted by FIVB in the last congress through its importance to help the continent to reach the world level. The board will also discuss the update of CAVB regulations with amendments adopted in the last FIVB congress in Argentina.

Each Executive committee member will make a proposal and a report for his responsibility and attributions sharing out as adopted in the last Executive committee in Cairo in June 2002.
